The Department of Archaeology presents workshops for undergraduate students, graduate students and other interested parties that introduce software useful for structuring text, producing good quality illustrations.

The modules offered are:

- **Graphics and Type-setting**
- **Introduction to GIS**

Graphics and Type-setting each consist of four two-hour practical sessions on Fridays. *Introduction to GIS*

consists of eight one-hour lectures and eight two-hour practicals, on Wednesdays and Thursdays respectively.
